Great Tribulation 1,335 Days

The Bible Refers to about 7,100 Years:

- 1,656 - Creation to Flood
- 989 - Flood to Exodus
- 3,430 - Exodus to 1994
- 4 - Tribulation
- 1,000 - Sabbath
- 20 - Margin of error
- 7,100 - Years total

Note: In some places the Bible offers a high level of precision on the record of time. In other places the record is less than absolute. Therefore, this data is subject to some conjecture on the part of the author.

5 Daniel Unsealed

The book of Daniel was sealed up until the time of the end. (Daniel 12:4,9) The time of the end is an appointed time. (Daniel 8:19) It is not an uncertain moment in God's plans, however, no one knows the day or hour of Christ's return. (Matthew 24:36)

The information sealed up in the book of Daniel was not the meaning of visions, for some visions have been understood for hundreds of years. What was sealed up were the rules of interpretation for apocalyptic prophecy. With these four rules, an ordinary person can determine the intended meaning of Daniel and Revelation.

A prophetic puzzle is only solved when ALL of the pieces are put in their right places...

Rule 1: Each apocalyptic prophecy has a beginning and ending point in time. Events occur in the order given.

Rule 2: A fulfillment only occurs when all specifications are met. This includes the order within the prophecy.

Rule 3: Apocalyptic language can be literal, symbolic or analogous. To reach the intended meaning, one must consider: (a) the context; (b) the use of parallel language in the Bible; and (c) if thought to be symbolic, relevant statements defining that symbol.

Rule 4: The presence or absence of the Jubilee Calendar determines how God reckons time: literal or day/year.
