A Do It Yourself Study Guide on Daniel and Revelation

Dear Friends:

I hope this little booklet proves to be helpful. I have diagramed the seventeen apocalyptic prophecies in Daniel and Revelation to demonstrate this rule: "Each apocalyptic prophecy has a beginning and an ending point in time and the events in each prophecy occur in the order given." I have not found one exception to this rule.

As you study through these charts with an open Bible, you should notice two phenomena. First, each prophecy contributes to a story that is much larger than itself. Second, all seventeen prophecies perfectly align with each other to produce a giant matrix of events from the past as well as the future. This timing matrix enables us to determine our chronological position within God's plan to save mankind.

You will notice that certain portions of Daniel and Revelation are not charted. This omission occurs because some passages in Daniel and Revelation contain commentary about events that were presented earlier or they are about to be presented. Revelation 17 is an example of this type of commentary. For purposes of comparison, I have also included three charts that show competing interpretations.

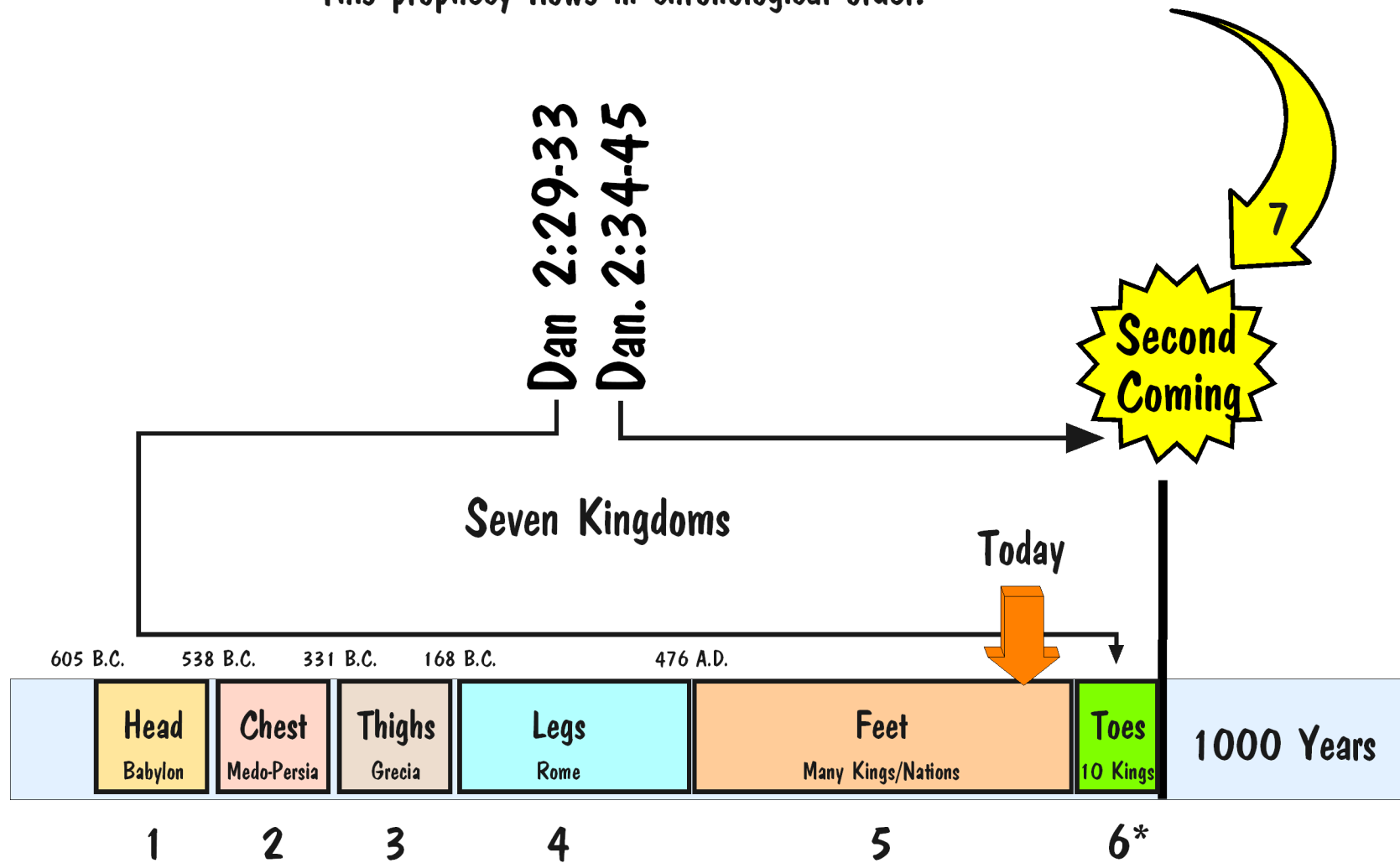

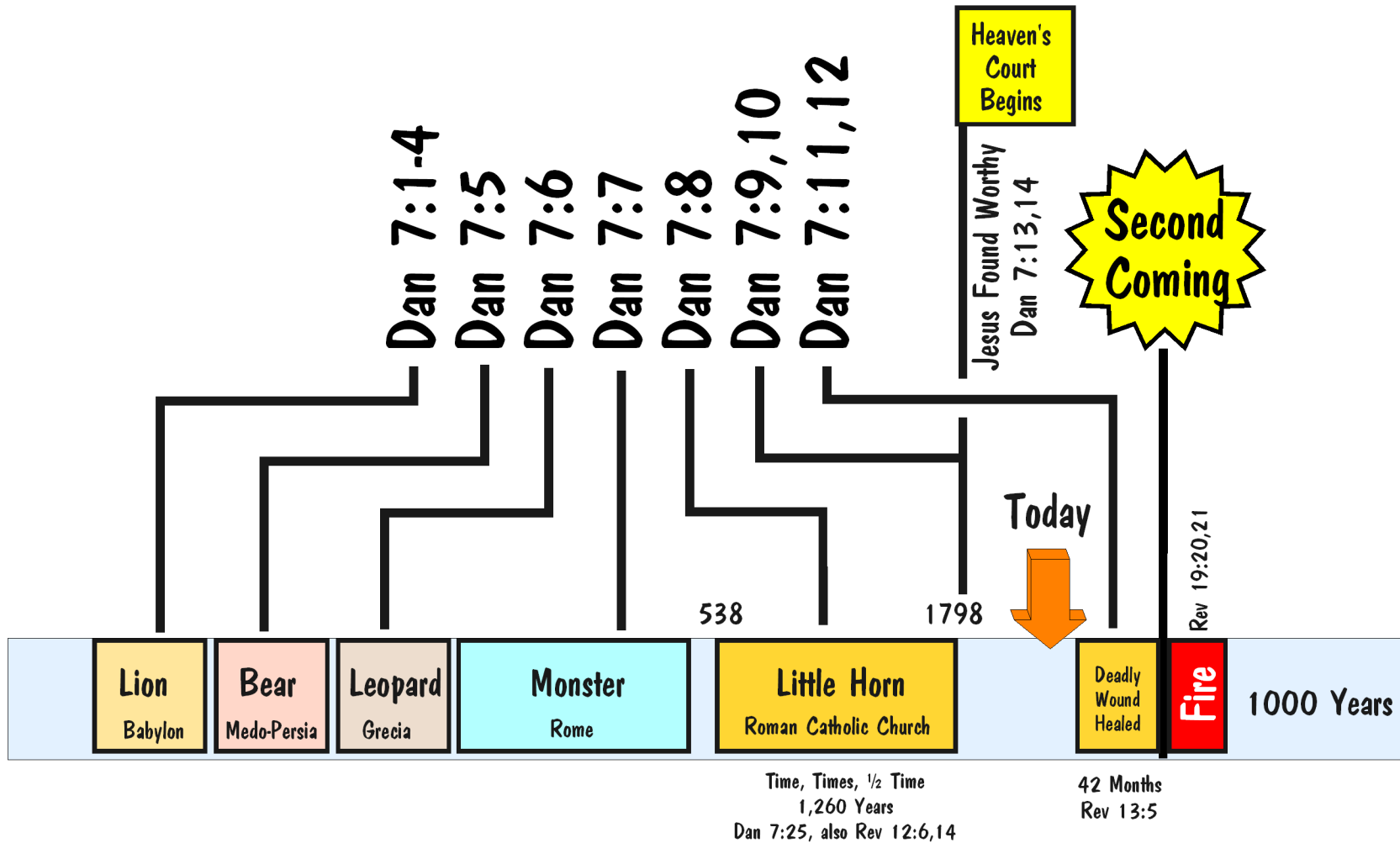
Prophecy #1 Dan 2:29-45

This prophecy flows in chronological order.



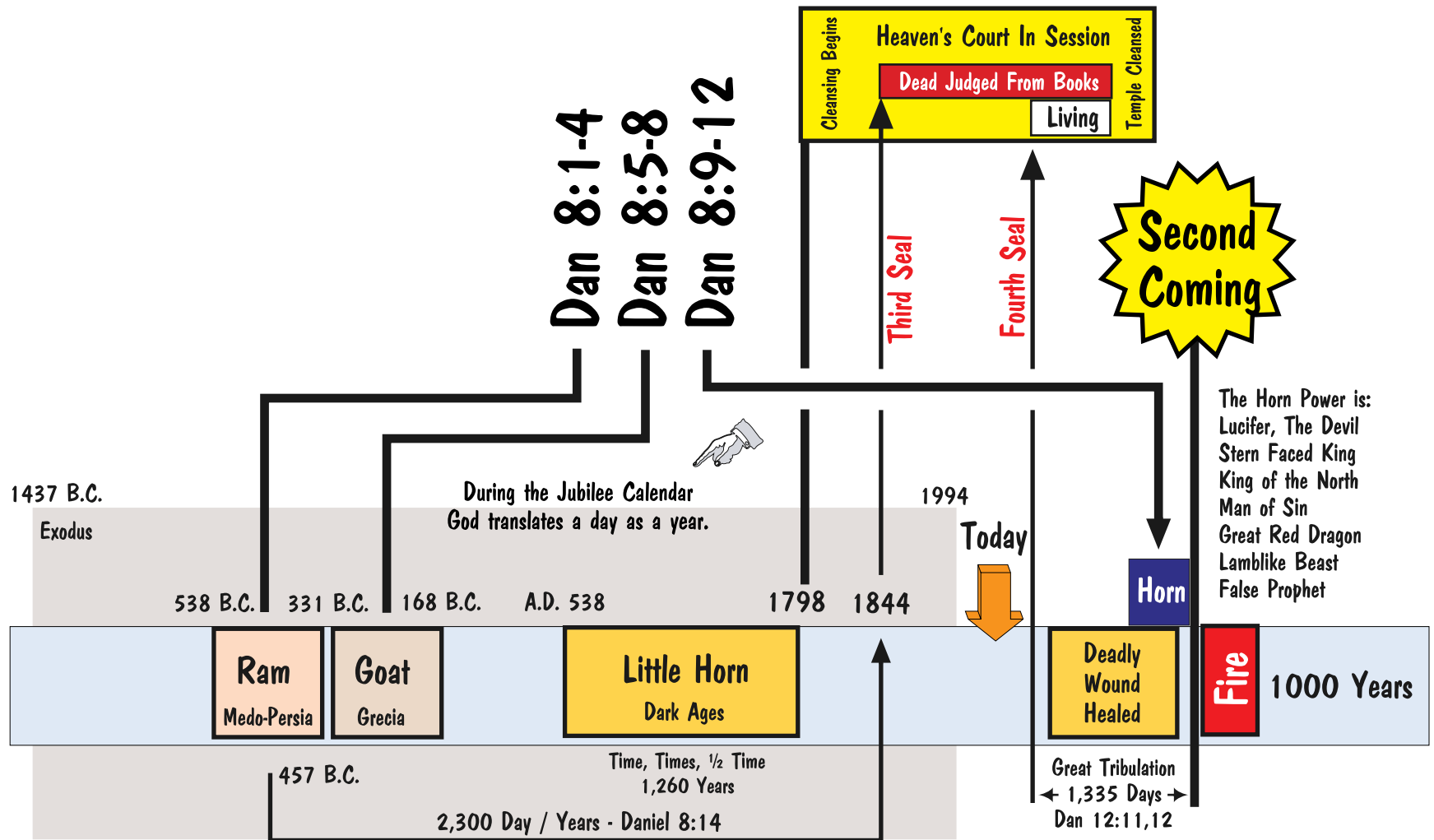
Prophecy #2 Dan 7:1-12

This prophecy flows in chronological order.



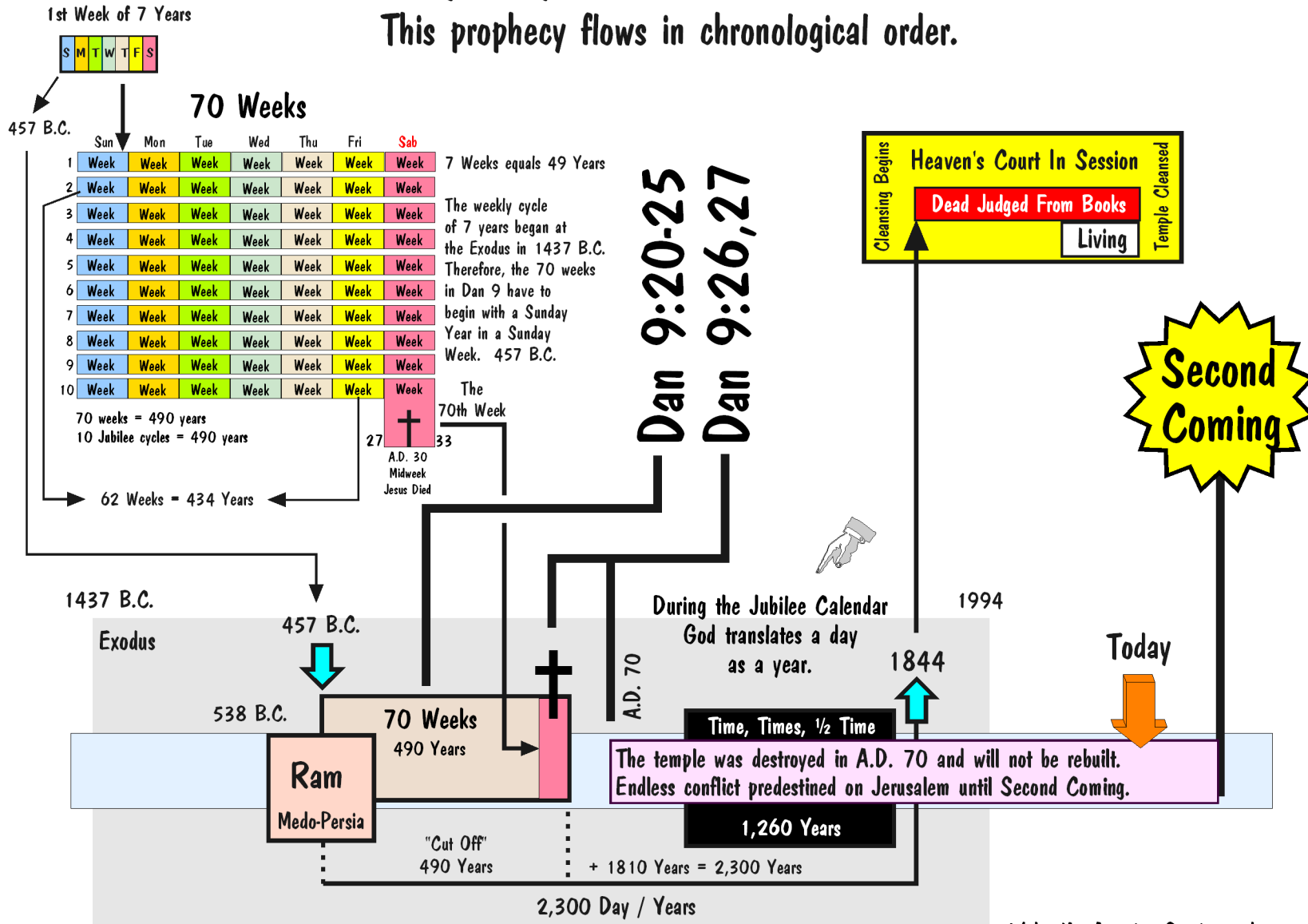
Prophecy #3 Dan 8:1-12

Prophecy #4 Dan 9:20-27

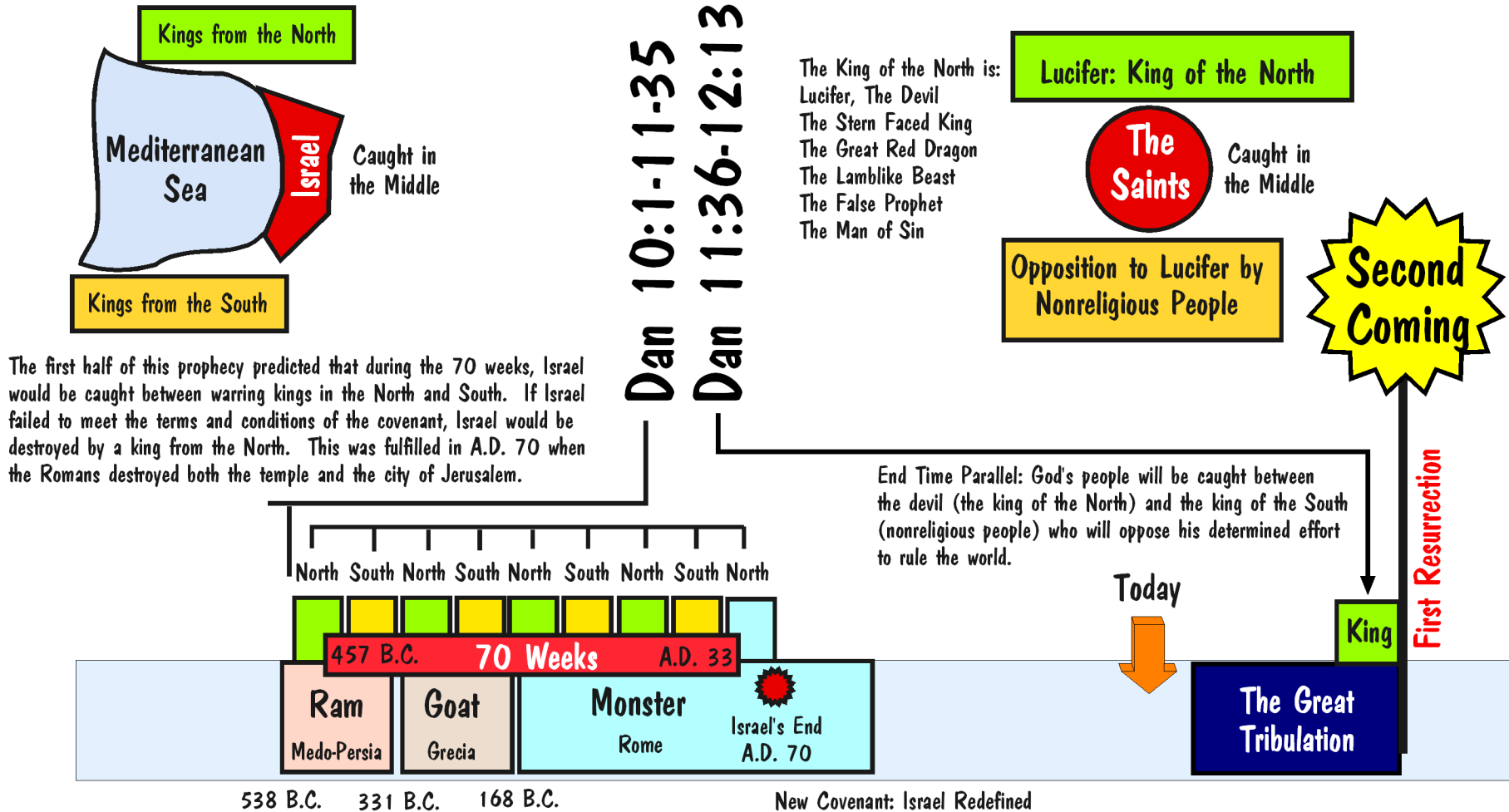
This prophecy flows in chronological order.



*Note: The 70 weeks were "cut off" of the 2,300 days. God gave ancient Israel 70 weeks of the 2,300 days to bring in everlasting righteousness (the kingdom of God). Israel failed. Nevertheless, Jesus died at Passover in A.D. 30, the middle of the 70th week (A.D. 27 - A.D. 33). The date of Christ's death is important to the 2,300 years because A.D. 30 affirms: (a) the decree given by Artaxerxes in 457 B.C. marks the beginning of the 2,300 days; and (b) 457 B.C. is both a Sunday year and a Jubilee year. This perfectly aligns with Hezekiah's 15th year Jubilee (702 B.C.). Further, this is why the 69 weeks are stated as 7 weeks (a Jubilee cycle of 49 years) and 62 weeks.

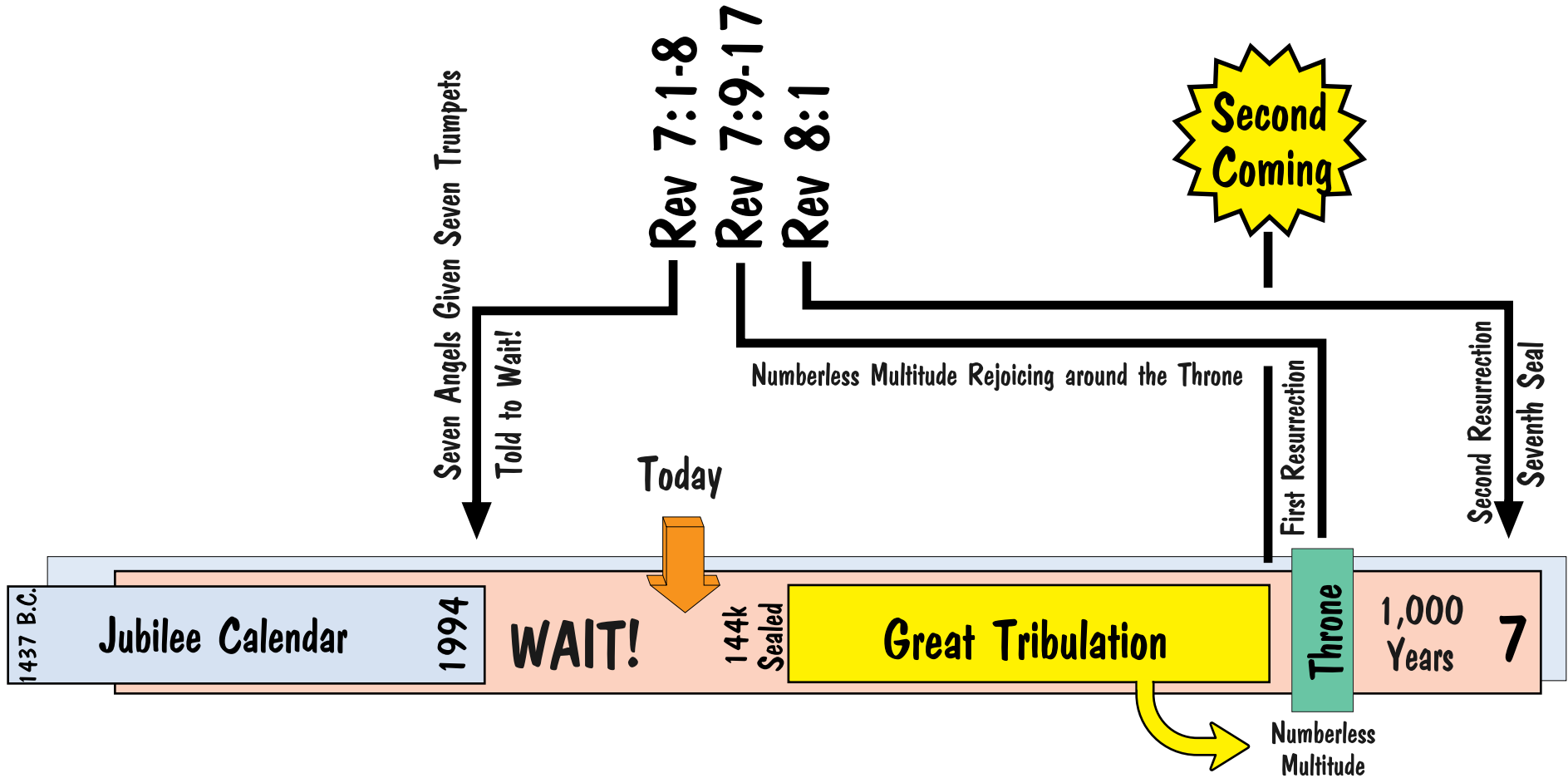

This prophecy flows in chronological order.



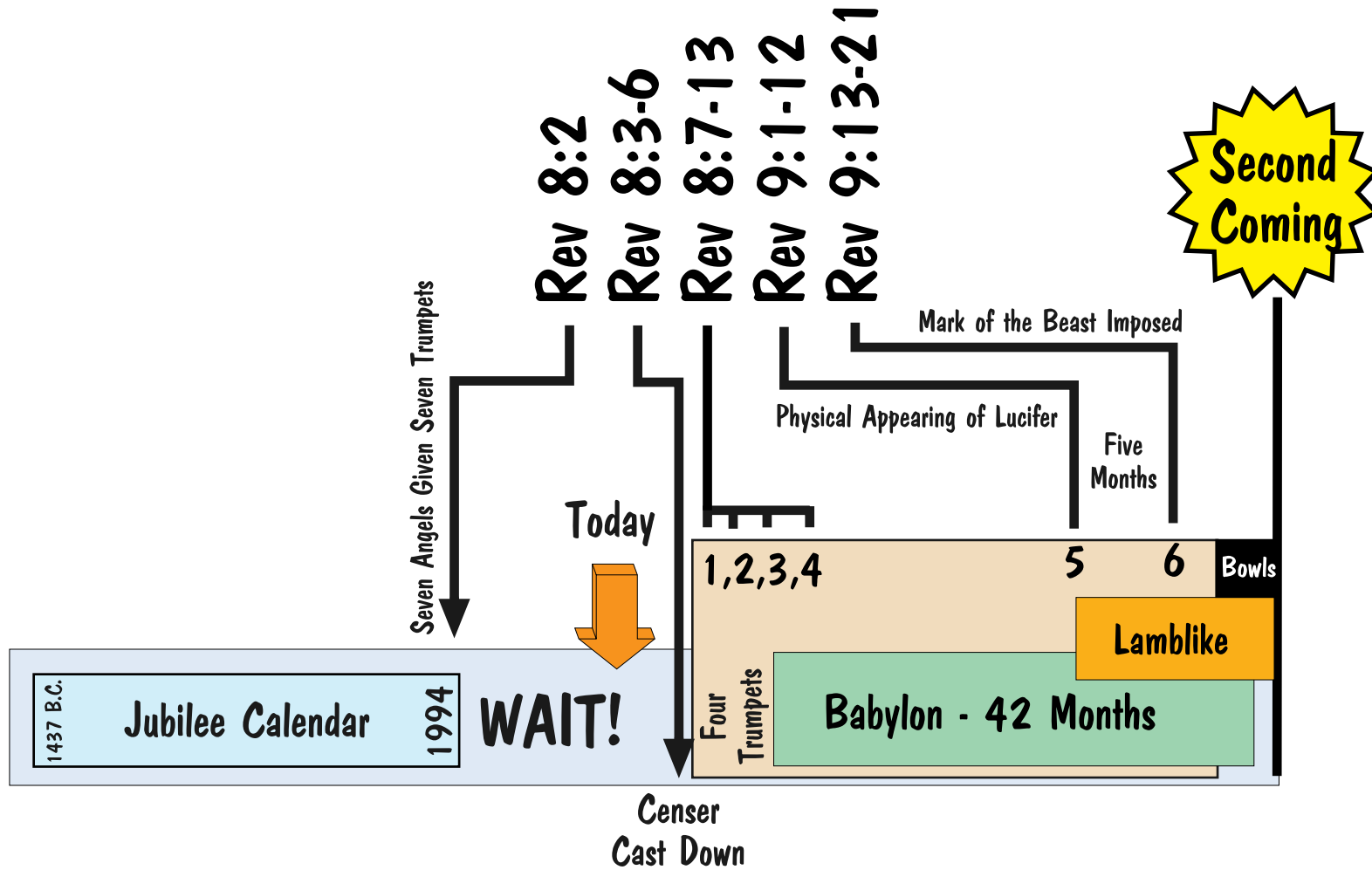
Prophecy #7 Rev 7:1-8:1

This prophecy flows in chronological order.



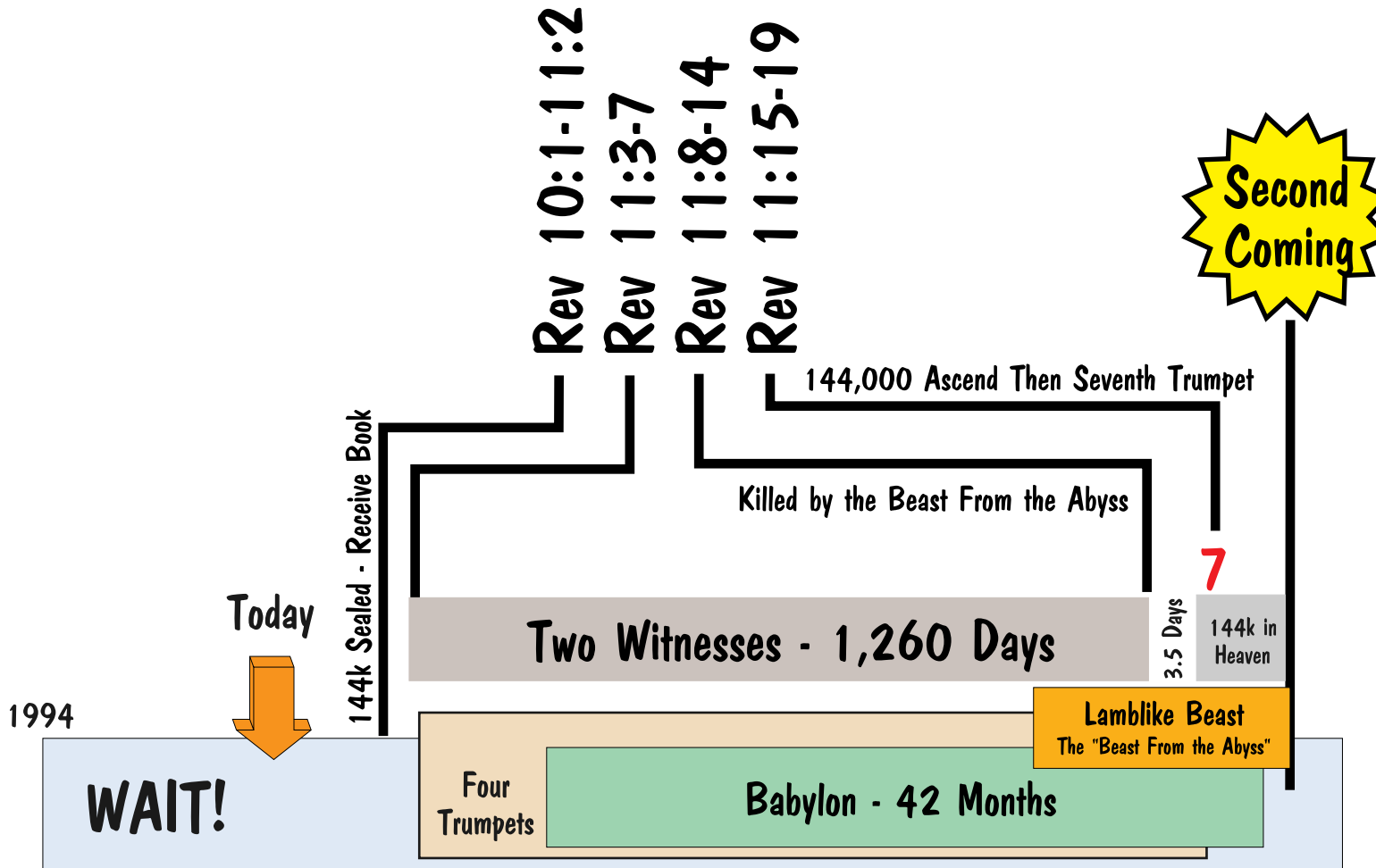
Prophecy #8 Rev 8:2-9:21

This prophecy flows in chronological order.



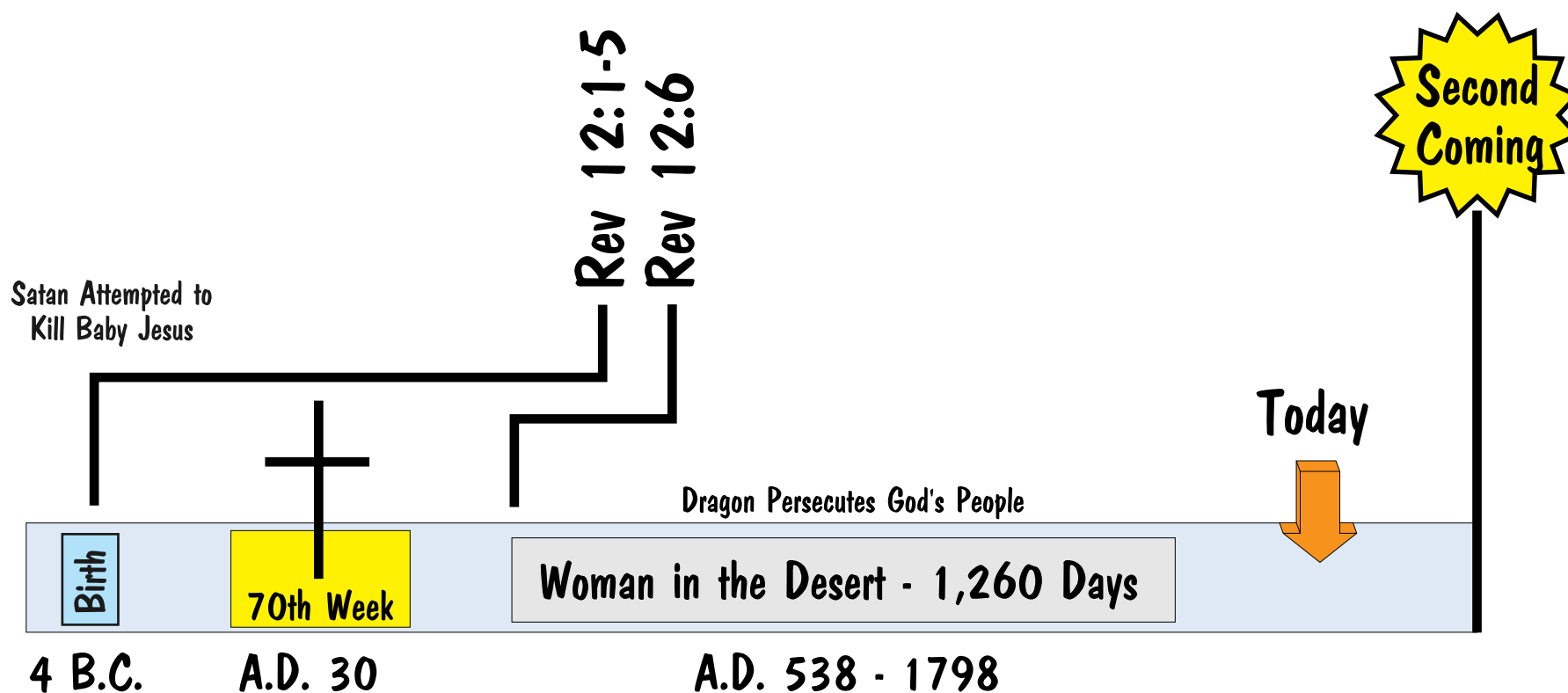
Prophecy #9 Rev 10:1-11:2

This prophecy flows in chronological order.



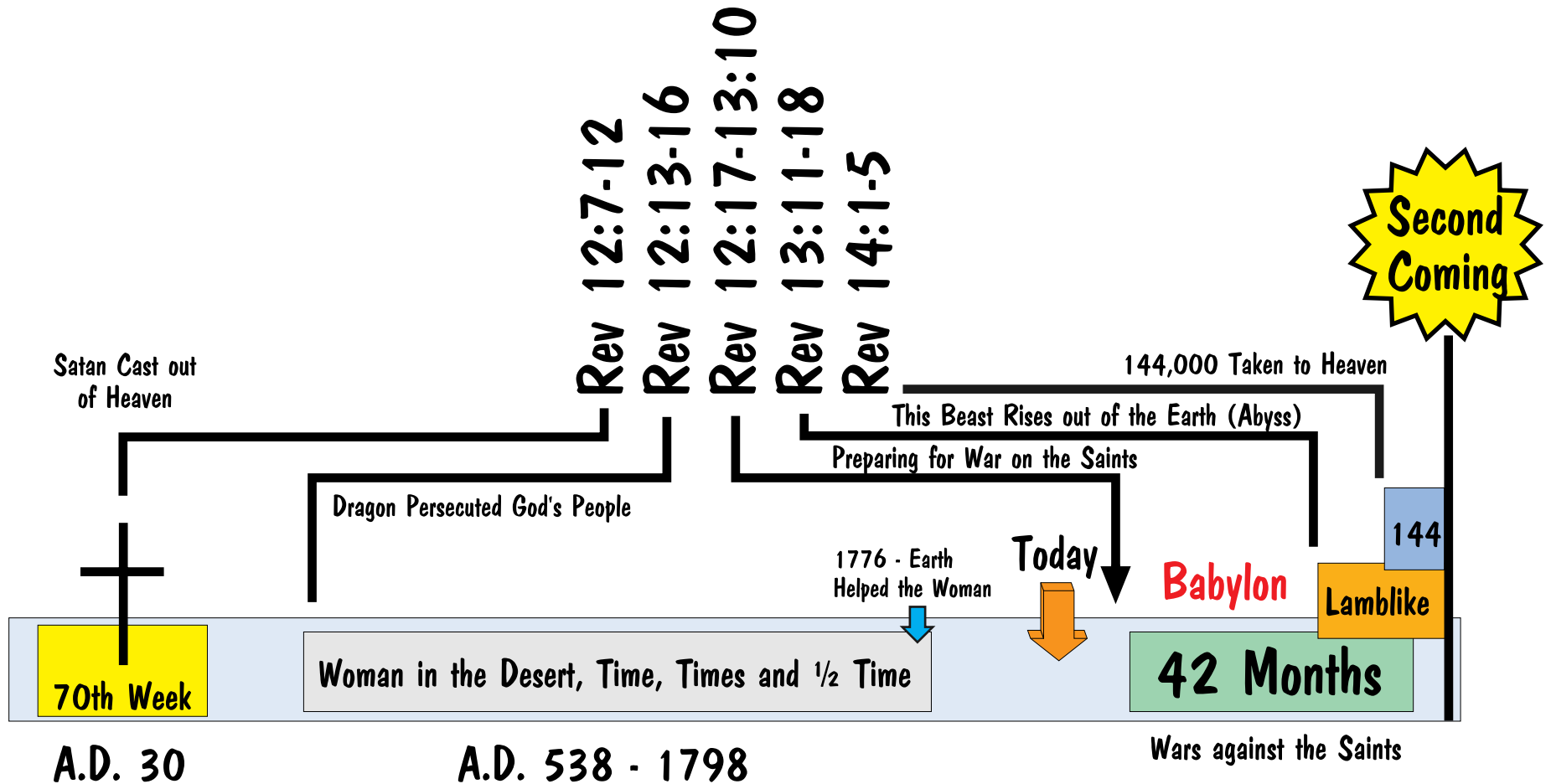
Prophecy #10: Rev 12:1-6

This prophecy flows in chronological order.



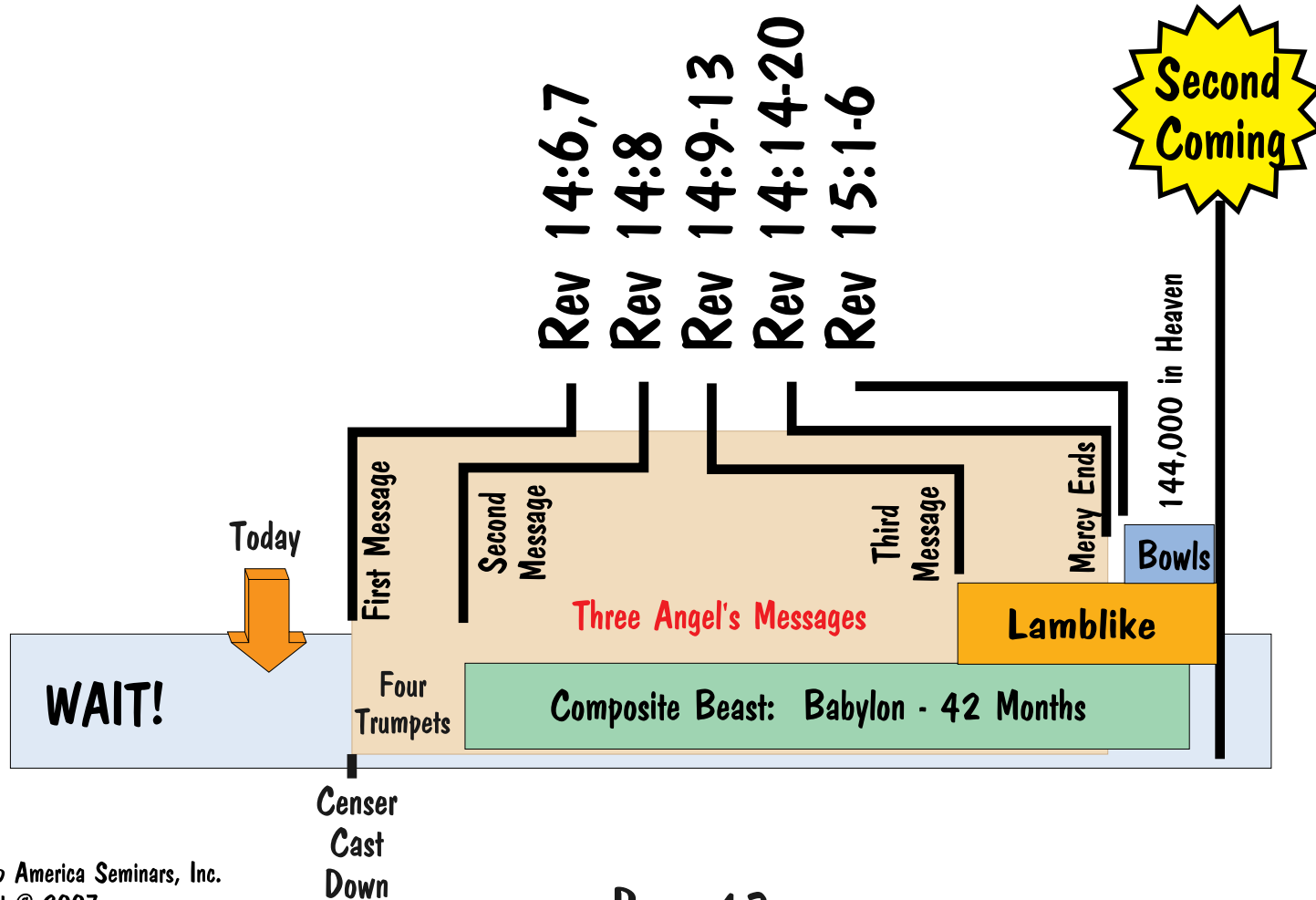
Prophecy #11: Rev 12:7-14:5

This prophecy flows in chronological order.



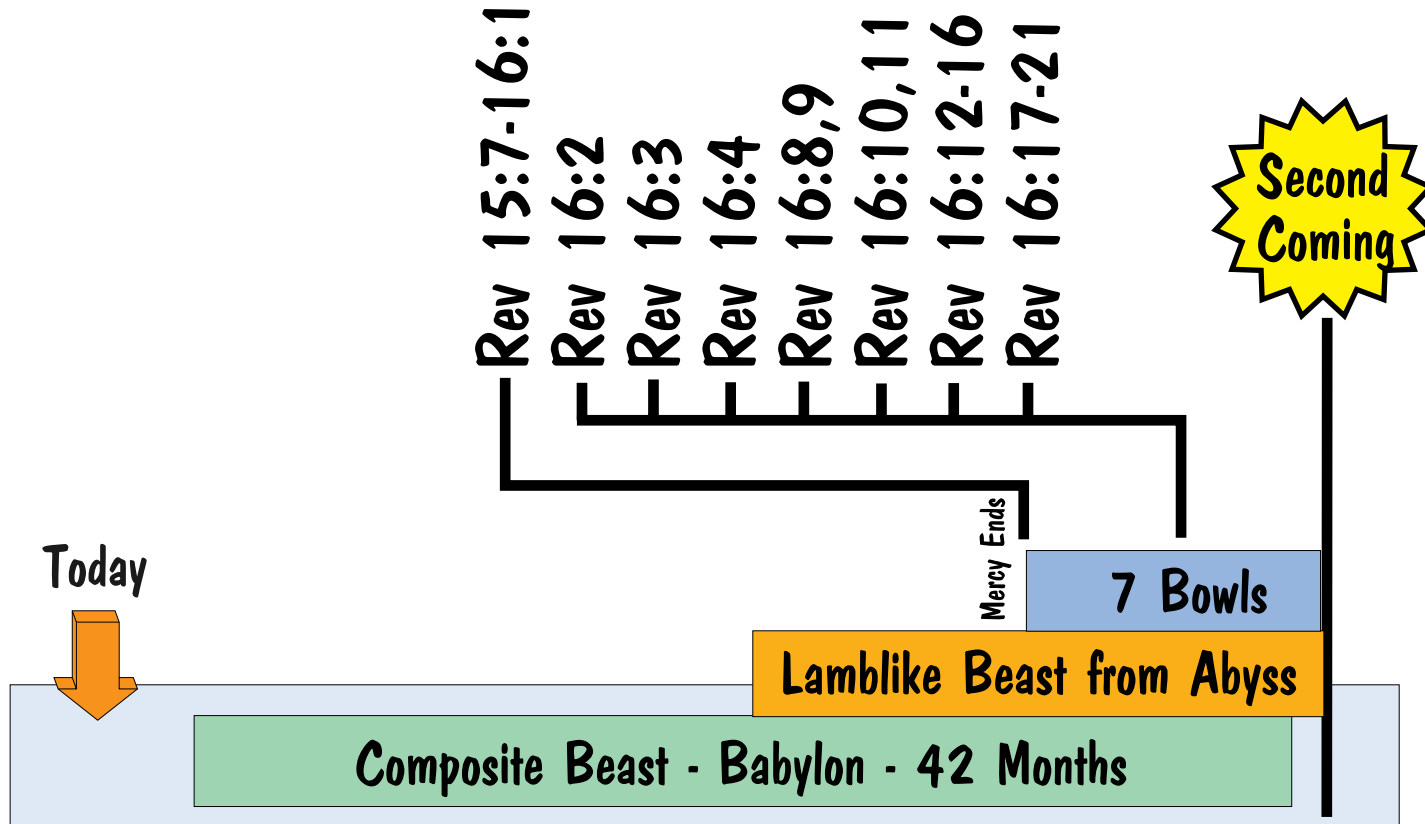
Prophecy #12: Rev 14:6-15:6

This prophecy flows in chronological order.



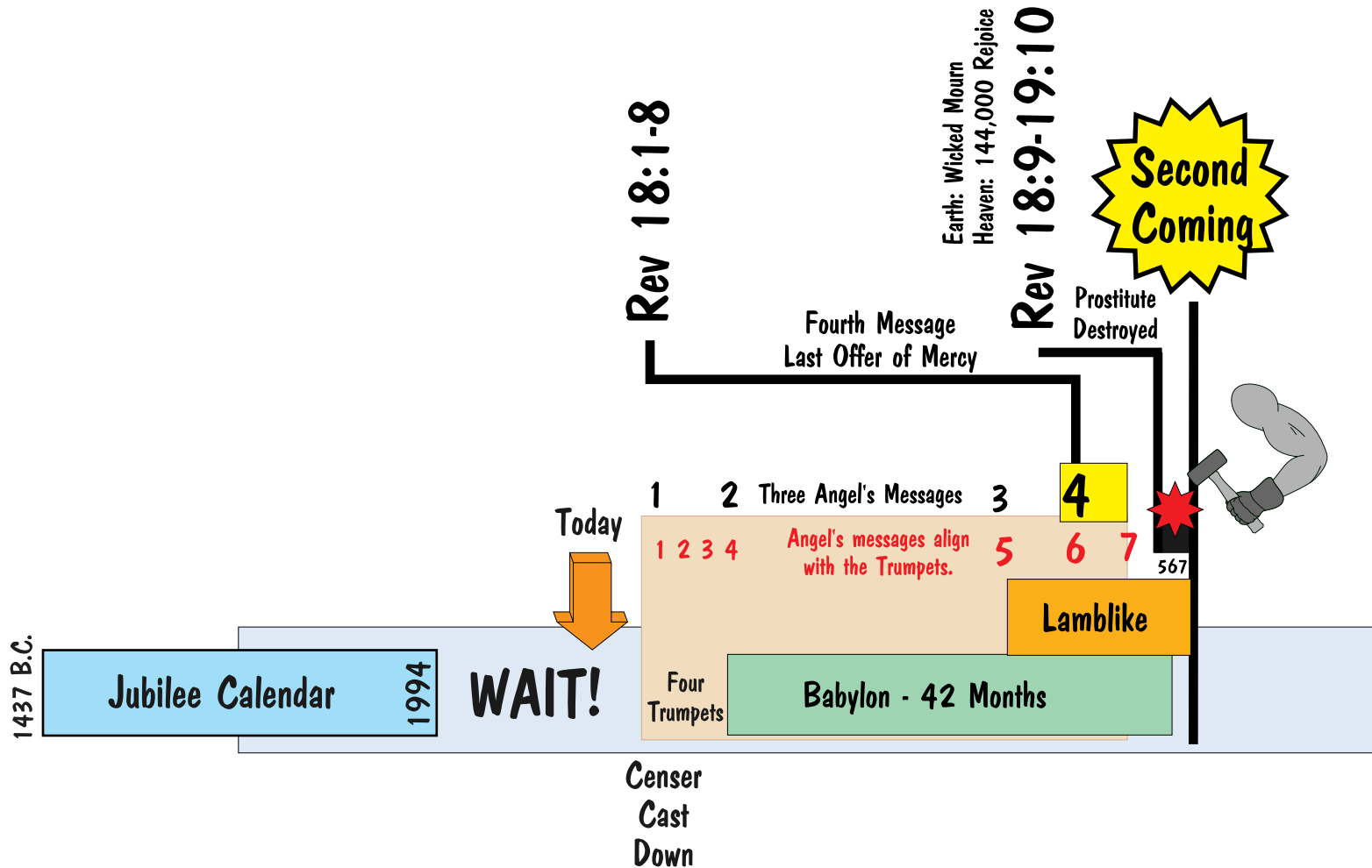
Prophecy #13: Rev 15:7-16:21

This prophecy flows in chronological order.



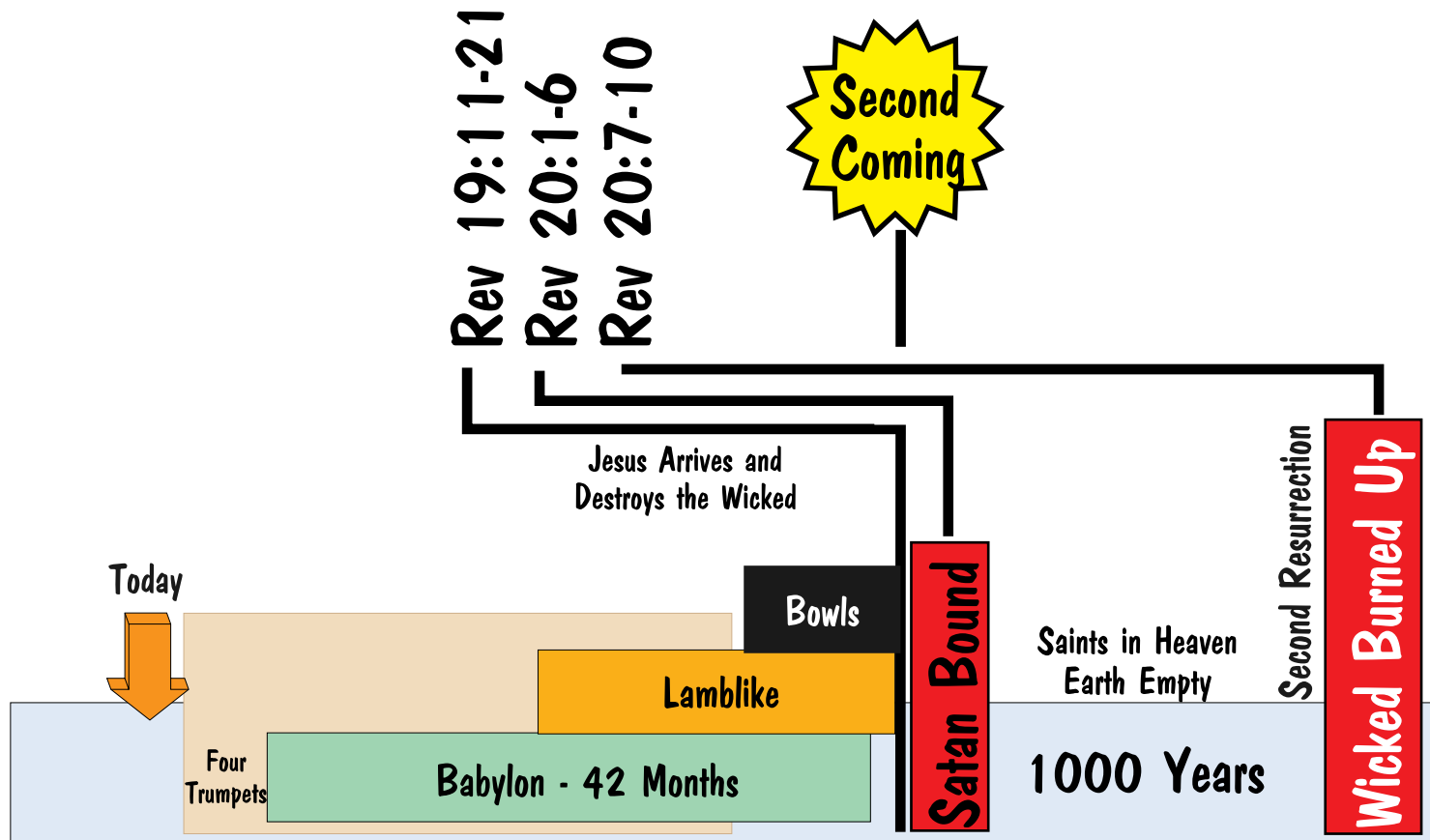
Prophecy #14: Rev 18:1-19:10

This prophecy flows in chronological order.



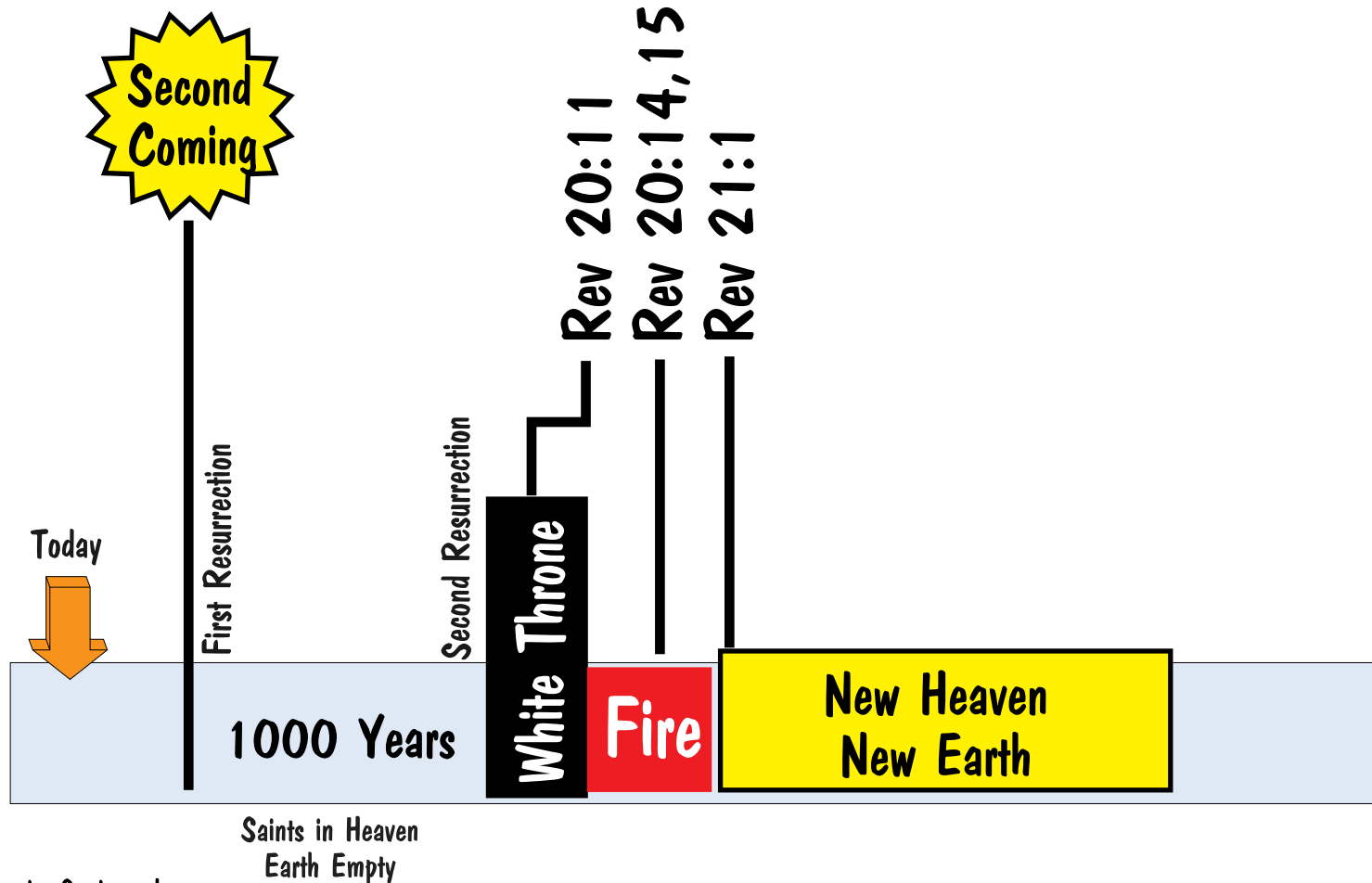
Prophecy #15: Rev 19:11-20:10

This prophecy flows in chronological order.



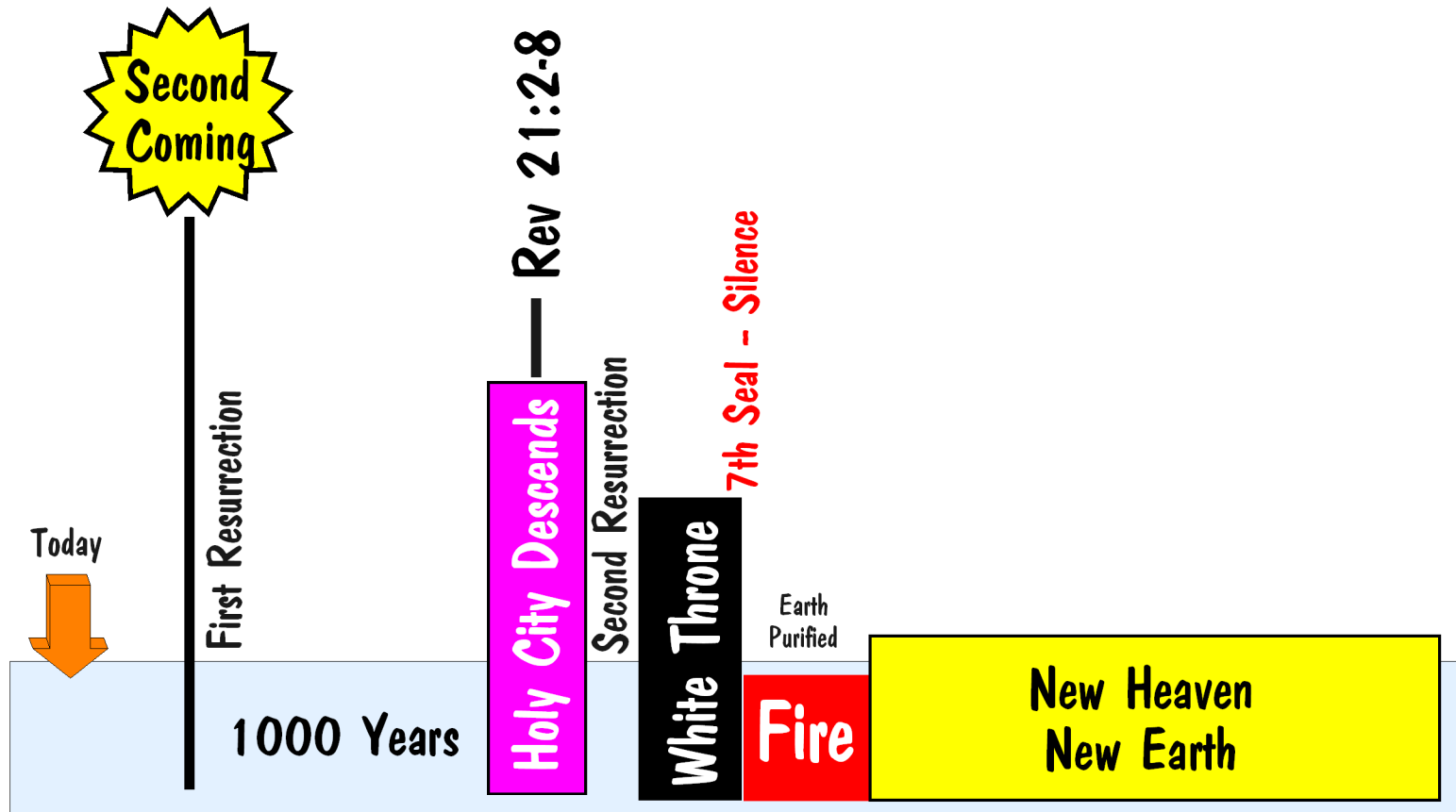
Prophecy #16: Rev 20:11-21:1

This prophecy flows in chronological order.

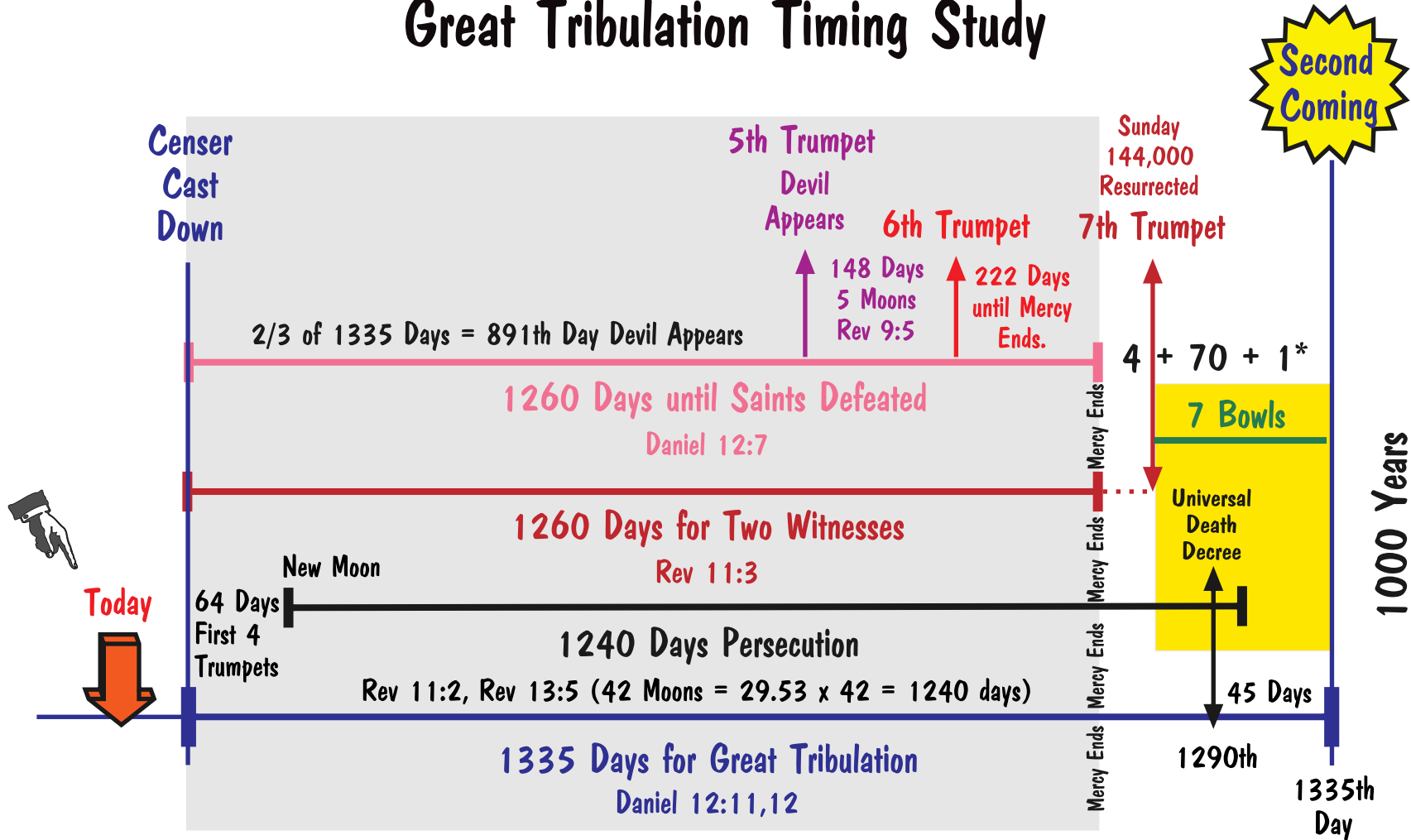

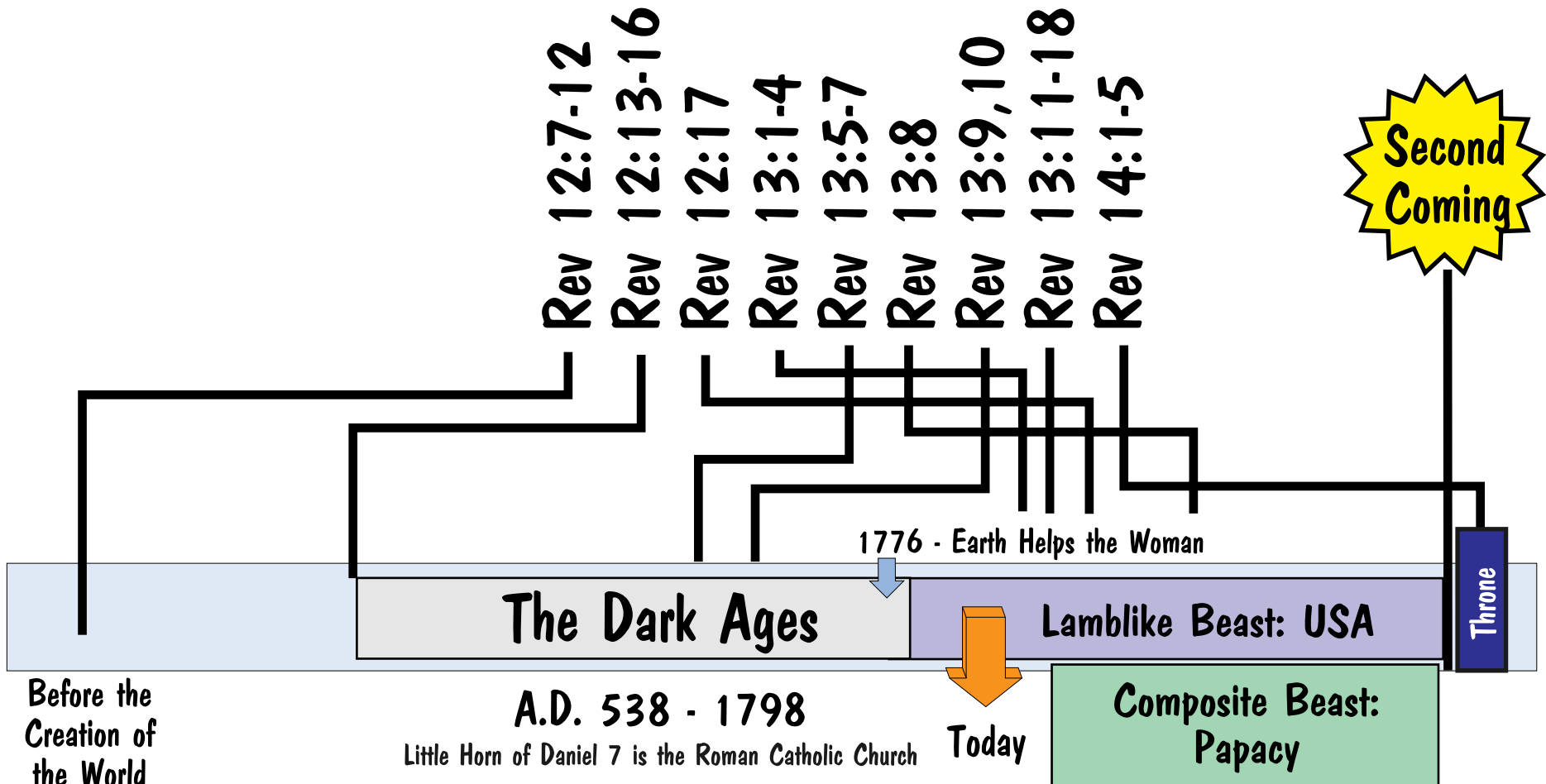
Great Tribulation Timing Study



*Mercy ends 1,260th day. Two Witnesses lie dead 3.5 days (covering 4 whole days). The 144,000 are resurrected on 1,264th day. Seventh Trumpet also occurs on this day. The Seven Bowls are 70 days in length (10 days each?). The last day is the 1,335th day or Resurrection Sunday! The 1335th day could be the beginning of a new Day / Week / Month / Year / Millennium.

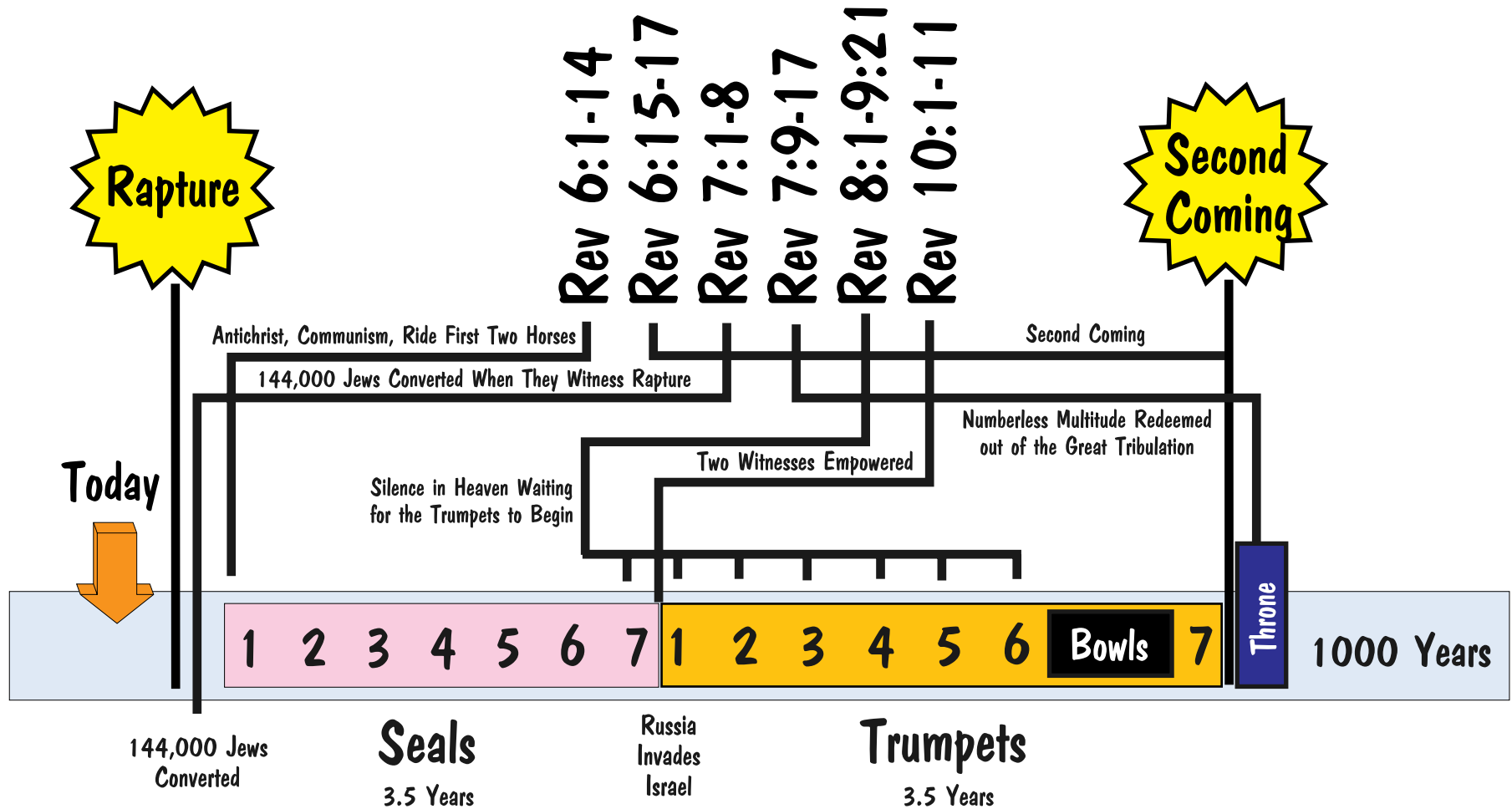
A Portion of the Historical View: No Chronological Order

Rev 12:7-14:5 Outlined



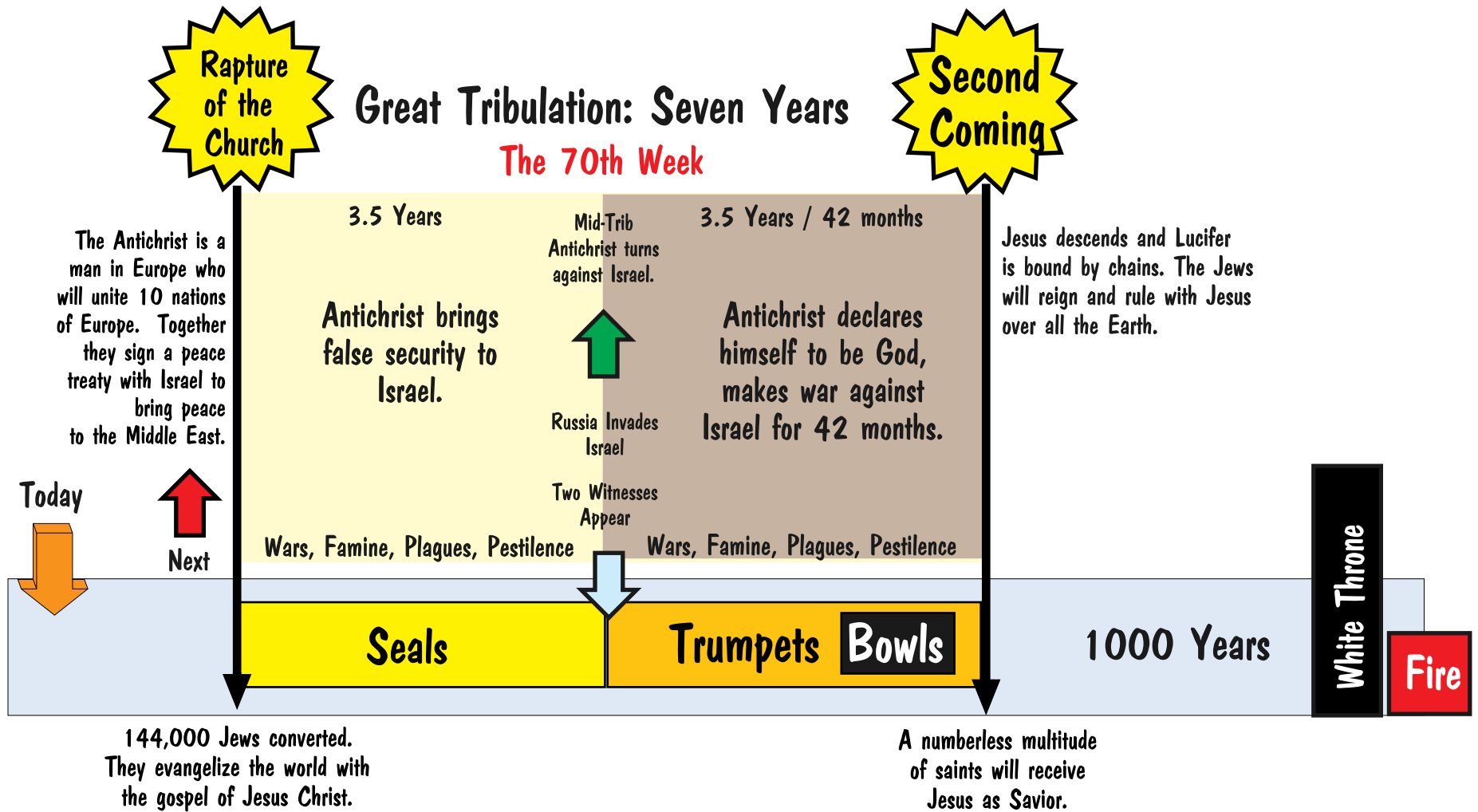
A Portion of the Rapture View: No Chronological Order

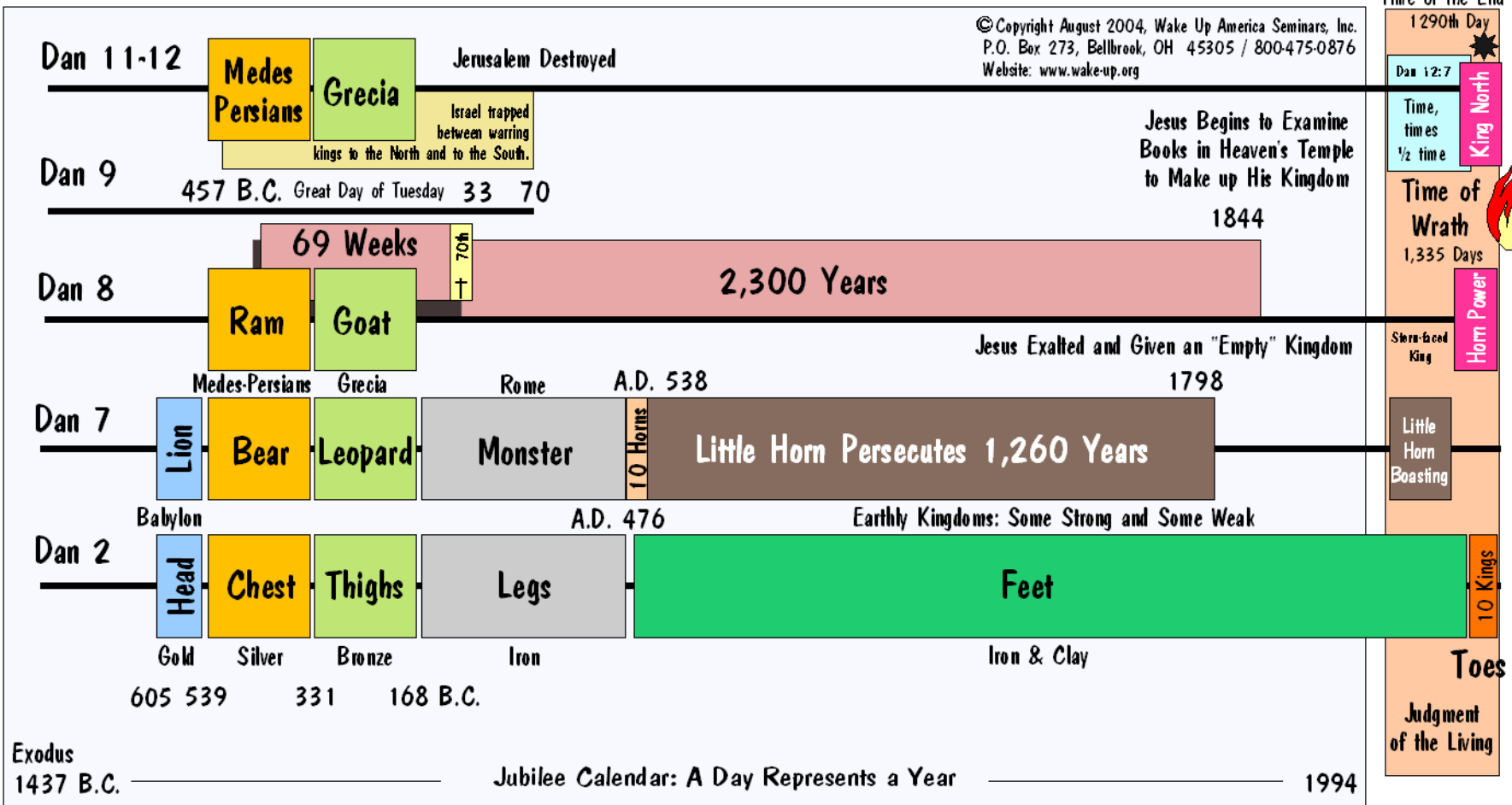

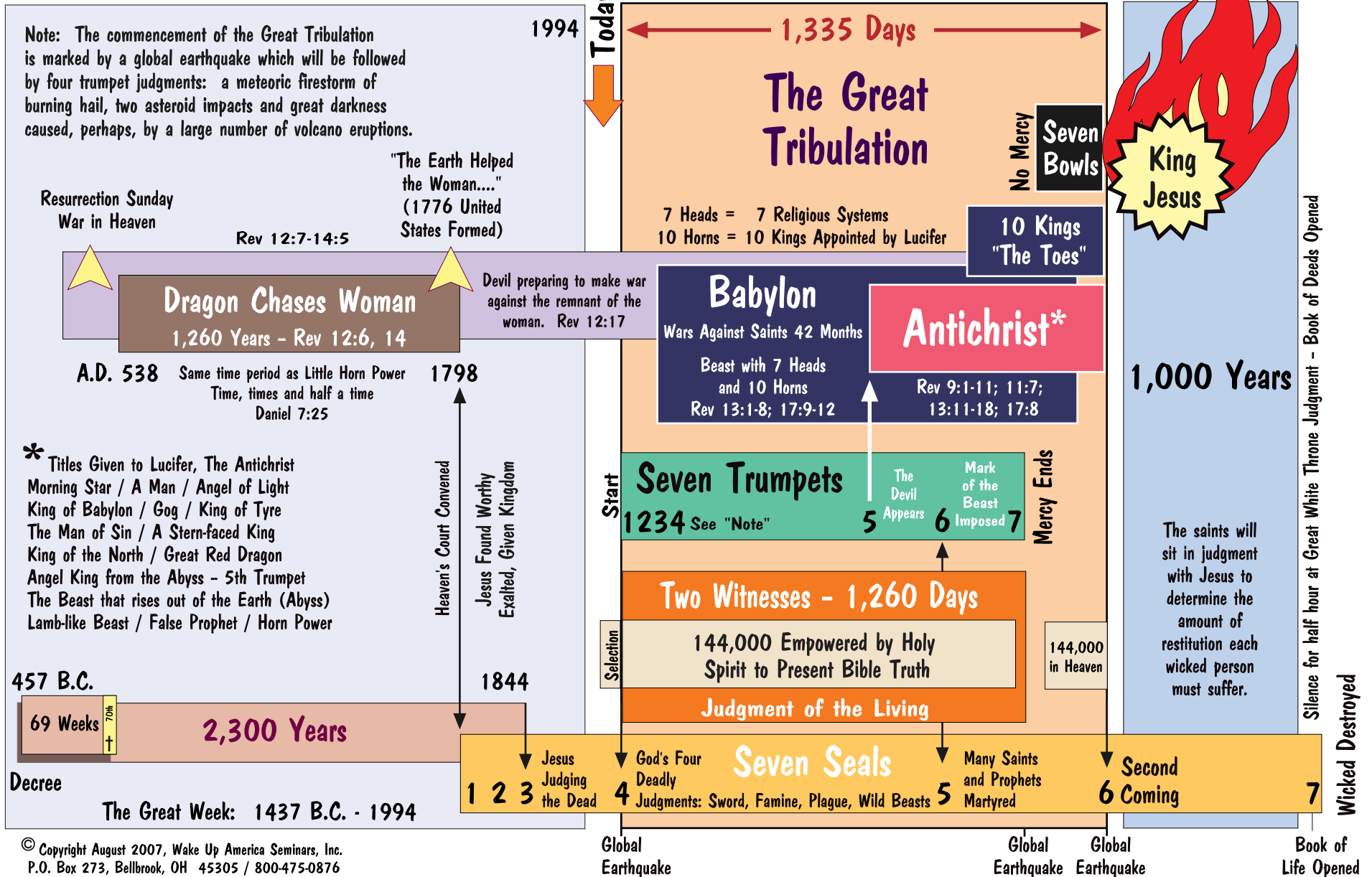
Four Rules of Interpretation

- Rule 1: Each apocalyptic prophecy has a beginning and ending point in time and the events must occur in the order they are given.
- Rule 2: A fulfillment only occurs when all of the specifications of a prophecy are met. This includes the order within the prophecy.
- Rule 3: Apocalyptic language can be literal, analogous or symbolic. To reach the intended meaning, one must consider: (a) context, (b) parallel language used elsewhere in the Bible, and (c) if symbolic, the element must be defined by a relevant text.
- Rule 4: The presence or absence of the Jubilee Calendar determines how God measures time in apocalyptic prophecy.
